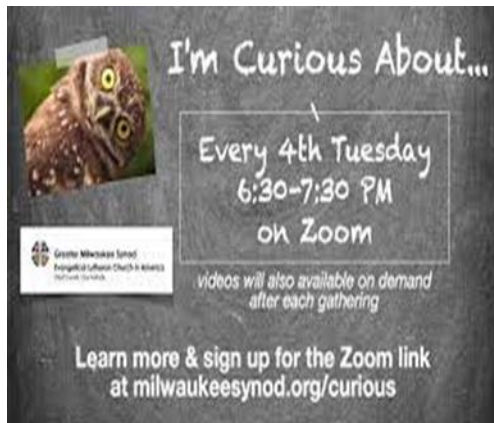
Fellowship:

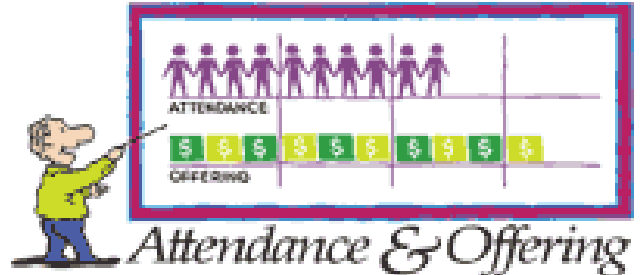
